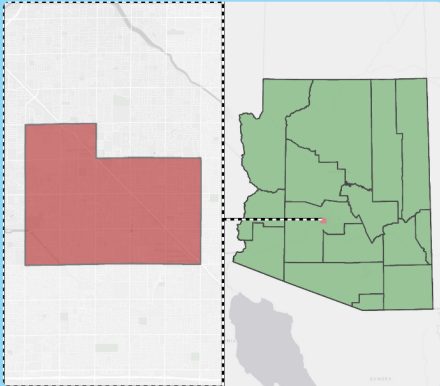

Glendale Central – 32 min (2018)

Maricopa – 26 min (2012–2016)

Average one-way commute time (minutes) for workers 16 years and older for all travel modes

In 2019, 7.5% of the population of Glendale Central lived within 150 meters* of a major highway.

In 2018, 14.3% of Glendale Central public schools (preK–4th grade) were sited within 150 meters* of a major highway.

* 150 meters is about 2 blocks.

Arizonans spend a considerable time traveling to and from work. Time spent commuting is associated with several health outcomes. Car commuters generally have higher exposure to vehicle emissions, including particulate matter, carbon monoxide, and black carbon, which can lead to negative respiratory outcomes such as asthma exacerbation.

Traffic-related air pollution is a major cause of unhealthy air quality, especially in urban areas. The closer your home or school is to a major highway, the more likely you and your family are to be exposed to traffic-related air pollution.

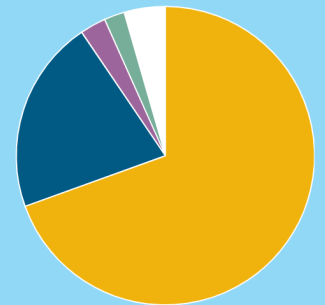
